Are you interested in learning more about your local estuary?

As an EstuaryWatcher you will participate in monitoring water quality and recording information regarding physical characteristics and changes to the estuary. This will help to determine change over time for management purposes.

EstuaryWatch is currently looking for interested persons to work with our existing monitoring groups, and potentially extend our monitoring to new estuaries.

We currently monitor 9 estuaries between Barwon River and Gellibrand River.
